General Information

Introduction

In order to promote orienteering, a group of orienteering enthusiasts started preparing for the establishment of an orienteering club in 1978. With the enthusiastic support of people from various sectors, the Hong Kong Orienteering Club was eventually founded in August 1979.

Principle

1. To promote orienteering in Hong Kong, so that people strengthen their self-confidence, cultivate their abilities to handle emergency and to make judgement, and develop their interest in the countryside through activities;
2. To nurture and sponsor members to participate in open orienteering events;
3. To exchange outdoor techniques, experience and knowledge with other outdoor activities' organisations.

Activity

The Club organises practice, open, night and relay orienteering events regularly. We also organise training courses in orienteering. In addition, various outdoor pursuits and recreational activities are provided for members.

Membership

Anyone who is interested in orienteering may become a member. Here are the categories of membership:

Membership Year

The membership year runs from 1 July to 30 June next year. However, if you are accepted to be a member from 1 January to 30 June, then your membership will expire on 30 June the year after.

Procedures for Acquisition of Membership

1. Fill in a membership application form.
2. Pay the appropriate fee (entry fee and annual subscription) by a crossed cheque which is payable to "Hong Kong Orienteering Club", or deposit the appropriate fee in the Sin Hua Bank (Bank of China Group, account number 031-377-10441357) and get a pay-in slip.
